# Comments for the week ending May 27th

There were 676 fed cattle sold through auctions this week up 134 head from last week and 211 more than the same week last year. Fed steers traded from \$143.77-\$155.52 averaging \$151.65 up \$4.40 from last week and just \$0.08 less than year ago prices. Fed heifers traded from \$135.80-\$154.49 averaging \$146.93 up \$0.07 from the previous week but \$5.60 less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as active with steady prices, one market reported trade as \$2.00 higher with Holstein steers \$1.00 cwt higher.

Ontario railgrade prices were reported at \$255.00-\$260.00 for steers and \$254.00-\$259.00 for heifers which is up \$3.25 from the previous week for steers and averaging \$2.75 higher for heifers. Average prices were down \$4.50 - \$3.75 compared to the same time last year. Producers reported that the cattle they sold this week were for delivery the first week in June.

Higher receipts of cull cows sold this week with 2,101 head sold through auction markets, up 158 head from last week but 363 fewer than the same time last year. Cows sold from \$67.93-\$94.03 averaging \$79.66 cwt, down \$1.87 from last week but \$3.57 above year ago prices. Auction markets reported strong trade with prices steady to last week. At the end of the week comments changed to beef cows selling fully steady but holstein and exports selling barely steady.

Higher receipts of 5,137 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week up 72 from last week and 995 higher than the same time last year. Auction markets reported calves as steady with yearlings selling stronger. Good quality light weight sold steady with plainer type cattle selling under pressure and heavier cattle selling slightly higher. Stronger prices continued to the end of the week. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs average \$7.29 lower, 500-600 lbs up \$6.42, 600-700 lbs down \$0.18, 700-

800 lbs up \$5.06, 800-900 lbs up \$5.29, and steers 900lbs and over averaged \$3.14 stronger than last week. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$18.18 on average from last week, while 400-500 lb heifers were down \$19.22, 500-600 lbs down \$6.80, 600-700 lbs up \$2.60, 700-800 lbs down \$6.19, and heifers 800 lbs and over were up \$2.89 from last week on average.

The Quebec electronic market for the week ending May 26<sup>th</sup> sold from \$257.00-\$257.50 cwt dressed FOB, down \$1.32 from the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade for the week ending May 26<sup>th</sup> was reported by Canfax as \$269.50-\$274.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Live steers traded at \$165.00.

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending May 26<sup>th</sup> was light Tuesday with live sales from \$118.00 - \$123.00 live. Wednesday saw trade from \$116.00-\$122.00 live, mostly from \$119.00 - \$120.00. Dressed sales on Wednesday were reported from \$187.00 - \$192.50 with the majority selling at \$191.00 steady to last week.
