Comments for the week ending September 23rd

Very light receipts of 215 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week which is down 128 head from last week and 199 fewer than last year at this time. Fed steers ranged from \$153.60-\$166.42 averaging \$159.90 down \$0.74 from last week but \$22.54 stronger than year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$155.30-\$164.60 averaging \$159.52 up \$3.20 from the previous week and \$24.61 above year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices steady to strong, with quality considered.

The Ontario railgrade prices are fully steady for the third consecutive week. Steers sold at \$270.00 dressed and heifers \$269.00-\$270.00 with delivery from the weeks of September 27th through October 11th. Last year at this time bids were hard to come by and trade was extremely limited at \$230.00 dressed, down \$40.00 from the current prices.

The Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier notes on Canadian buyer activity: "Big retailers are likely reassessing feature plans and merchandising strategies for December. Christmas ads are being finalized. Price points are probably going to be much less attractive than at any time in the past. Normal turn business volumes are being reassessed given new price points. Meanwhile distributors are stepping far back from the market as they wait for prices to find some bottom."

2,219 fed/cull cows were sold this week through Ontario auction markets, up 13 from last week and 277 more than this time last year. Cows traded from \$63.68-\$92.34 averaging \$77.12 down \$2.09 from last week but \$5.88 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active at steady prices mainly, with one market noting prices up \$1.00-\$2.00 cwt on good demand. By mid-week, trade was noted as selective but with prices holding steady and ended the week with a large offering selling barely steady.

Larger receipts of stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week at 5,397 head, up 1,230 from last week and 652 more than the same week last year. Auction markets reported lighter weights as active at steady to fully steady prices. Grass cattle were noted at a premium. Heavier cattle were fully steady to slightly higher noting a larger percentage of this week's trade is over 700 lbs. By week's end all classes were steady to strong with quality considered. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$5.55 from last week, 500-600 lbs down \$0.44, 600-700 lbs up \$5.44, 700-800 lbs down \$3.82, 800-900 lbs down \$6.30, 900-1000 lbs down \$0.58 and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$3.94 stronger than last week on average. Heifers 300-400 lbs were up \$22.94, 400-500 lbs up \$24.38, 500-600 lbs up \$5.87, 600-700 lbs down \$0.04, 700-800 lbs down \$2.41, 800-900 lbs up \$7.54 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$8.71 above the previous week on average.

The Quebec electronic market for this week ranged from \$272.00-\$273.75 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, which was up \$0.70 from the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light to moderate this week with Canfax noting prices fully steady to \$1.00 cwt higher from \$264.00-\$265.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reported: "All three western Canadian packers bought cattle. Cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the middle to late October delivery. This week's cash offering has been clean up."

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending September 17th was moderate to active mainly on Wednesday. Overall, average prices for the week, as reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers average \$123.88 down \$0.91, while live heifers averaged \$124.19 down \$0.06. On the rail, steers averaged \$198.64 dressed, down \$2.18, while heifers averaged \$198.82 dressed, down \$2.48.

This week's US trade was light to moderate in all feeding states on Wednesday with a few scattered deals developing Thursday. Trade was steady to strong in the south from \$123.00-\$124.00 live. The north was easier with trade reported from \$191.00-\$198.00 dressed, mainly \$196.00-\$198.00 down \$1.00-\$3.00 cwt with a few sales from \$123.00-\$125.00 live. Friday, the market is fairly quiet with just a few clean up deals expected, if anything. Asking prices on the remaining cattle are reported at \$124.00 live in the south and \$198.00 dressed in the north. The Cattle On Feed Report will be released later this afternoon.
