



### Comments for the week ending October 21st

408 fed steers and heifers sold through Ontario auction markets this week up 193 head from last week and 168 more than the same time last year. Fed steers ranged from \$145.56-\$164.00 with a weekly weighted average price of \$157.18 down \$1.03 from the previous week but \$24.44 stronger than year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$138.98-\$160.48 averaging \$153.23 up \$2.67 from last week and \$26.98 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as steady to fully steady, with quality considered. By week's end trade was firm.

Ontario railgrade prices were reported as steady again this week with steers mainly \$270.00 dressed and heifers \$269.00-\$270.00, with a few premium steers selling a couple of dollars stronger to provincial plants. Cattle that sold this week are scheduled for delivery the week of November 8<sup>th</sup> and some into the week of November 15<sup>th</sup>. Average prices are sitting \$39.00 above last year at this time.

The Ontario processing volume at federally inspected plants, as of the week ending October 16<sup>th</sup> is 479,779 head, up 4% from the same time in 2020. Weekly processing volumes in the last 13 weeks have been above 12,000 head with the exception of three weeks, all holiday shortened weeks. During the same time frame last year, processing volumes federally did not get above 11,867 head. On a provincial level, processing volumes in 2021 as of August 30<sup>th</sup> are sitting at 60,188 head, up 7.2% from 2020 with steer and heifer volumes up and cull cows numbers lower.

Larger volumes of fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week noting a larger volume of beef cows starting to come to market. 2,673 head sold which is up 545 from last week and 430 more than last year at this time. Cows sold from \$49.27-\$77.44 averaging \$61.92 up \$0.81 from last week and \$1.44 stronger than last year at this time. Cows were reported as steady to strong to start out this reporting period. As the week progressed trade was barely steady to \$5.00 easier, but ended the week holding steady.

Larger receipts of stocker and feeder cattle sold through auctions this week at 10,411 head, up 2,864 from last week and 2,008 more than this time last year. Auction markets reported calves as steady on the good quality and vaccinated, but plainer types sold selectively at barely steady prices. Yearlings were reported as steady with quality considered to softer, but ended the week barely steady. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs down \$17.17 from last week, 500-600 lbs down \$19.58, 600-700 lbs down \$1.53, 700-800 lbs up \$3.01, 800-900 lbs down \$1.07, 900-1000 lbs down \$1.10 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$0.48 stronger than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$9.48, 400-500 lbs down \$18.03, 500-600 lbs up \$2.98, 600-700 lbs down \$3.74, 700-800 lbs down \$12.50, 800-900 lbs down \$12.87 and heifers 900 lbs and over average \$3.64 easier than last week's weighted average price.

The Quebec electronic market for this week ranged from \$265.00-\$266.25 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, down \$0.39 from the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light this week with trade on Wednesday from \$261.00-\$263.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Thursday business was reported by Canfax at \$260.00-\$263.00 delivered, steady to \$2.00 lower than last week's sales. Canfax reports: "Cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the second half of November delivery. There were a couple instances where cattle would not be picked up until the first week in December. It was a tough week for both the fed cattle and non-fed market this week. Western Canadian packer competition on both markets were limited."

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending October 15th saw a full range of prices from \$122.00-\$124.50 live in the south and \$122.00-\$125.00 live and \$193.00-\$200.00 dressed in the north. Average prices for the week, posted by the USDA Mandatory Price report, saw live steers average \$123.84 up \$0.88 from the previous week while heifers averaged \$123.83 up \$0.30. On the rail, steers averaged \$195.70 up \$0.33 from the week before while heifers averaged \$195.62 up \$0.05.

The US cash cattle trade this week was light to moderate Wednesday, with southern trade fully steady at \$124.00 live. In the north dressed deals were also steady from \$195.00-\$198.00 dressed, mainly \$196.00, while some live trade was steady to \$1.00 stronger at \$124.00-\$125.00 with a couple in lowa at \$127.00. Thursday a few deals were noted in Nebraska at steady prices of \$196.00 dressed and \$124.00 live while the rest of the feeding states were quiet. Some clean up deals are possible today however little price change is expected. The Cattle On Feed Report was released this afternoon stating on feed numbers are down 1% from last October, placements were down 3% and marketings also down 3% from October 2020.
