Comments for the week ending November 11th

There were much lighter receipts of fed steers and heifers this week at auctions at just 262 head, down 169 from last week and 227 less than the same time last year. Fed steers sold from \$120.31-\$162.06 averaging \$147.91 down \$10.52 from last week but \$13.16 stronger than year ago prices. Fed heifers ranged from \$135.17-\$159.50 averaging \$152.61 down \$5.38 from last week but \$20.86 above last year at this time. Auction markets reported active trade with prices steady to fully steady, with quality considered.

The Ontario railgrade market continued fully steady again this week at \$270.00 dressed for steers and \$269.00-\$270.00 for heifers, with delivery as far out as the weeks of December 5th to 13th. This week's average price is up \$42.00 cwt from last year at this time, when trade was very limited and bidding spotty with sales reported at \$228.00 delivered.

The Boxed Report by Kevin Grier noted Canadian Spot Market as: "Both big plants in Alberta worked on Saturday and Cargill Guelph worked overtime each day last week. Kills in Canada would have been among the largest of the year last week. I expect packers have work to do on inventories but are probably in better position than those in the U.S. Packers will have spot product but buyers will not have much leverage."

2,607 fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week up 347 from last week and 375 more than this week last year. Cows sold from \$52.01-\$77.03 averaging \$62.55 up \$1.97 from last week and \$1.54 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as mainly steady, with a few markets noting prices \$2.00-\$5.00 cwt higher, with larger volumes of beef cows coming to market this week.

6,576 stocker and feeder cattle were sold through auction markets this week, up 172 from last week but 289 fewer than the same time last year. Auction markets reported vaccinated calves as steady to fully steady with good buyer interest, with unvaccinated calves under pressure. Heavier cattle were noted as selling on a strong active trade at steady to selectively steady prices. Actual prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs down \$4.32 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$5.23, 600-700 lbs down \$8.81, 700-800 lbs down \$17.51, 800-900 lbs down \$2.50, 900-1000 lbs down \$10.90 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$6.08 above last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were up \$12.18 from last week, 400-500 lbs up \$9.07, 500-600 lbs down \$8.95, 600-700 lbs down \$9.80, 700-800 lbs down \$6.37, 800-900 lbs down \$6.92 and heifers 900 lbs and over were up \$0.98 from last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market for this week ranged from \$265.75-\$267.00 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, fully steady to the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday and Thursday with Canfax reporting sales from \$260.00-\$263.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax notes trade as: "Mostly steady with bids and sales seen last week. Live sales were reported just over 154.00 FOB the feedlot. Most of the cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the week of December 6th delivery."

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending November 5th was light on Tuesday, but very scattered on Wednesday and Thursday as sellers held out for higher prices, and were successful this week. Prices on Friday were \$2.00 higher than early week trade. Sales in the south ranged from \$126.00-\$130.00 live up \$2.00-\$5.00 cwt. Deals in the north ranged from \$200.00-\$206.00 dressed, mainly \$202.00-\$204.00 with a few live sales from \$127.00-\$130.00. Overall prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price report, saw steers averaging \$129.23 up \$2.94 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$129.04 up \$3.22. On the rail, steers averaged \$202.81 up \$2.92 with heifers averaging \$202.31 up \$2.27.

The US cash cattle trade this week was fairly quiet until Wednesday where light to moderate trade took place in all feeding states. Trade in the south ranged from \$128.00-\$132.00 live, mostly \$131.00-\$132.00, up \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt from the previous week. Deals in the north ranged from \$204.00-\$209.00 dressed, mainly \$206.00-\$207.00 up around \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt with live trade noted from \$131.00-\$132.00. Thursday a few scattered deals were noted from \$131.00 live in the south which is steady, and \$206.00-\$207.00 dressed in the north with a few from \$131.00-\$133.00 live, steady to \$1.00 stronger than Wednesday's higher market. Today a couple of deals in the south were steady at \$132.00 live while the rest of the country was quiet. It appears that business for the week has been completed.
