
Demand was strong, generally, with extra strength in the lighter weight steer categories. There were 36 consignors and 18 purchasing buyers.




Comments for the week ending March 17th

390 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week up 72 from last week but 86 fewer than the same time last year. Fed steers sold from \$165.20-\$176.69 averaging \$170.55 up \$2.42 from last week's weighted average price and \$29.76 above year ago pricing. Fed heifers ranged from \$160.74-\$173.20 averaging \$168.38 up \$0.70 from the week before and \$29.65 stronger than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices barely steady to \$1.00-\$2.00 stronger to start. As the week progressed, trade was steady mid-week and ended the week \$2.00 cwt higher

The Ontario railgrade market this week was light with prices fully steady. Steers were reported mostly at \$290.00 dressed for delivery the week of March 28th, with a couple selling at \$293.00 for next week delivery. Heifers sold at \$290.00 dressed on limited volumes, with delivery also for the week of March 28th. This week's average price is up \$49.50 cwt from last year at this time.

About steady receipts of cull cows continued to trend higher again this week with 2,175 head sold through auction markets down 37 from last week and 224 fewer than this time last year. Cows sold from \$79.49-\$111.75 averaging \$94.03 up \$1.82 from last week and \$26.71 stronger than year ago prices. This week's average price is the highest since June 2017. Beef cow volumes were up slightly from last week averaging \$98.69 cwt, up \$1.01 from last week's weighted average beef cow price. Auction markets reported active trading on a good demand with prices steady to very strong.

Slightly larger volumes of stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week at 4,016 head, up 70 from last week but 702 fewer than last year at this time. Auction markets reported calves as active at steady prices, with grass types selling higher. Medium quality calves were steady with quality considered. Yearlings were reported as active at steady prices also. Actual average prices saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$18.27 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$1.02, 600-700 lbs down \$4.97, 700-800 lbs down \$0.47, 800-900 lbs up \$2.84, 900-1000 lbs up \$0.06 and steers 1,000 lbs and over averaged \$0.68 easier than last week's prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$33.49 on average but on light receipts, 400-500 lbs

down \$15.35, 500-600 lbs down \$12.08, 600-700 lbs down \$3.18, 700-800 lbs up \$0.84, 800-900 lbs down \$6.91 and heifers 900 lbs plus averaged \$1.83 lower than last week's weighted average price.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$297.00-\$298.75 dressed on a picked-up basis, up \$4.13 from the previous week's average prices. Volumes were reported as limited with all sales going to Quebec plants.

Alberta direct trade was light this week with Canfax noting the bulk of trade this week from \$274.00-\$275.00 delivered on a dressed basis, steady to \$3.00 cwt stronger than last week's prices but around \$1.00 stronger on average. Canfax reports: "This is the second week in a row one packer has not been bidding on fed cattle and will be the second week in a row cattle will be carried over. Inventory wise, feedlots are not gaining currentness and we will continue to deal with big cattle."

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending March 11th was light to moderate with prices easing lower. The USDA Mandatory Price Report listed live sales for the week ranging from \$136.00-\$141.00, with steers averaging \$138.30 down \$2.31 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$138.14 down \$2.68. On the rail trade was reported from \$21.00-\$222.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$220.11 down \$4.40 and heifers \$220.01 down \$4.64.

This week the US cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Wednesday and Thursday with prices in the south mainly \$138.00 live which is fully steady to last week. In the north a few deals have been reported on a live basis from \$138.00-\$141.00, steady to a touch stronger but the bulk of trade was on a dressed basis with sales from \$220.00-\$225.00, mainly \$221.00-\$222.00 up \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week. Some clean up trade is possible but it appears the bulk of trade has been completed.
