



OBCFPP LICENCE CHANGES

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Comments for the week ending July 27, 2023

Extremely light receipts of fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 214 head, down 190 from the previous week and 142 fewer than last year at this time. Fed steers traded from \$221.95-\$242.25 averaging \$234.11 cwt up \$1.13 from the week before and \$55.40 stronger than year ago prices. Fed heifers ranged from \$223.60-\$238.91 averaging \$232.48 cwt down \$0.02 on average from the week before but up \$60.93 from this time last year. Auction markets reported trade as steady with quality considered, but by week's end trade was noted as \$2.00 cwt easier.

The Ontario railgrade market the week ending July 21st did see a couple of fill in deals at \$400.00 cwt dressed for steers with delivery the week of July 31st, otherwise the market was untested. One federal packer was reported as bidding \$395.00 dressed prior to removing their bid mid-week. This week bids surfaced on Tuesday with trade reported at \$392.00 dressed for steers and \$391.00 for heifers with delivery the week of August 7th and some into the week of August 14th. By Wednesday bids were pulled back to \$389.00 dressed for steers and \$388.00 for heifers with delivery still the week of August 14th but trade reported was limited. Most of this week's deals were at \$392.00 for steers with the week averaging \$391.50 cwt down \$6.00 cwt from the last reportable trade two weeks ago. Prices this week are up \$85.50 cwt from the same week last year.

Slightly lighter receipts of fed/cull cows sold this week with auctions reporting 1,985 head down 54 head from last week but 217 more than last year at this time. Cows ranged from \$103.32-\$151.60 with a weekly weighted average price of \$124.03 up \$1.13 cwt from the week before and \$25.97 higher than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active on strong demand with prices steady to stronger, with some up \$4.00-\$5.00 cwt. By week's end trade was barely steady to early week's stronger market. 284 head of this week's trade was beef cows down 164 head from the previous week, averaging \$140.22 cwt up \$2.35 on average from the weighted average beef cow prices the week before.

Lighter receipts of stocker and feeder cattle this week totaled 1,830 head down 406 from last week and 754 fewer than the same time last year, noting two auctions took this week off. Auction markets reported trade as active with good demand and prices steady across the board, on light receipts. The market ended the week with calves selling fully steady to strong and yearlings strong to stronger with quality considered. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$8.03 cwt from the previous week's weighted average price with steers 500-600 lbs down \$1.15. Steers 600-700 lbs averaged \$9.17 easier, 700-800 lbs down \$2.09, 800-900 lbs down \$5.01, 900-1000 lbs down \$3.77 and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$5.63 below last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were up \$33.57 on average on very light receipts, 400-500 lbs up \$37.14, 500-600 lbs up \$18.59, 600-700 lbs down \$9.93, 700-800 lbs down \$29.93, 800-900 lbs down \$29.49 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$7.41 cwt lower than last week on average.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$388.00-\$400.75 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, down \$1.36 cwt from the previous week's trade.

Alberta direct trade was light with prices reported by Canfax at \$395.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis, down \$4.00-\$5.00 from last week on average. Canfax reports: "In some spots bids were reported at 392.00 delivered but selling interest was limited. Cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the second half of August delivery. Competition on the cash market was not as strong as last week. Sale volumes are shaping up to be very light this week. Looking briefly at the non-fed market, we're getting a sense that non-fed numbers through commercial auction facilities have started to tighten."

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending July 21st took place mainly Thursday and Friday with a stronger tone. Business in the south ranged from \$180.00-\$187.00 live, majority at \$180.00 which is \$2.00 cwt higher than the week before. In the north some live trade was reported at \$188.00 cwt up \$2.00 from the week before with dressed deals ranging from \$290.00-\$300.00 cwt, mainly \$295.00 up \$3.00-\$5.00. Overall average prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory price report saw live steers average \$186.19 up \$1.92 cwt with live heifers averaging \$186.10 up \$1.39 from the previous week. On the rail steers averaged \$294.72 up \$3.38 with heifers averaging \$294.22 up \$2.51.

This week in the US, the offering is reported as lower in volume that last week in all feeding states. Monday saw a couple of deals in Iowa from \$188.00-\$190.00 live which is steady to \$2.00 higher and Thursday was noted at \$292.00 dressed down \$2.00-\$3.00, but not nearly enough have sold to establish a trend. All other feeding states were untested. Bids were few and far between with just a few noted in parts of the south at \$175.00 live but sellers showed no interest. At time of reporting bids are starting to surface in the south at \$176.00-\$178.00 live while asking prices are holding firm at \$180.00-\$182.00 live. Bids in the north are surfacing at \$292.00-\$295.00 dressed, steady to \$3.00 lower but sellers are not showing any interest with asking prices sitting around \$296.00 plus dressed cwt. Active trade may or may not develop today as sellers are digging in for higher prices and packers do not appear to be interested in paying more, but with that said, one side is going to have to give if business is going to develop this week.
