Comments for the week ending August 17, 2023

Higher volumes of fed cattle sold this week, 283 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, up 94 head from the previous week and 81 more than the same week last year. Fed steers sold from \$215.99-\$239.47 averaging \$228.43 down \$2.49 cwt from the week before and \$45.49 stronger than last year at this time. Fed heifers ranged from \$219.12-\$239.41 averaging \$231.66 up \$5.77 from last week but \$56.52 above year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady to slightly higher this week. Holstein steers sold very strong.

The Ontario railgrade market held fully steady this week with trade reported at \$389.00 cwt dressed for steers and \$388.00 cwt for heifers. Delivery is being reported for the week of September 11th.

Higher receipts of fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week at 2,202 head, up just 28 head from the week before and 368 more than the same week last year. Cows sold from \$101.44-\$149.47 averaging \$123.51 up \$1.22 cwt from the previous week and \$23.42 stronger than year ago prices. All auction markets reported trade as steady across all classes with one report as steady to slightly higher compared to last weeks trade. Cows sold on a good demand. 380 beef cows were reported this week, up 82 head from last week, averaging \$136.92 down \$3.04 from the previous week's weighted average beef cow price.

Receipts of stocker and feeder cattle were higher this week noting two auctions last week took the week off. There were 3,085 head sold through auction markets up 1,950 head from the previous week and 138 more than the same week last year. Auction markets reported trade as all classes sold steady, a good offering of cattle selling \$3.00-\$5.00 cwt higher. Calves sold steady and yearling steers and heifers sold steady with some selling \$2.00-\$4.00 higher. Trade was strong with continued higher prices. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$39.93 cwt from the week before, 500-600 lbs up \$36.20, 600-700 lbs up \$25.79, 700-800 lbs up \$14.59, 800-900 lbs down \$5.27, and steers 900 lbs plus averaged \$6.77 cwt stronger than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 400-500 lbs were up \$26.84 on average, 500-600 lbs up \$48.76, 600-700 lbs up \$40.13, 700-800 lbs up \$40.99, and over 800 lbs averaged \$14.01 higher than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market for the week ending August 16th ranged from \$404.50-\$407.00 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, up \$8.14 cwt from the previous week's trade.

Alberta direct trade for the week ending August 17th saw no trade on Tuesday but the offering was steady with the previous week. Wednesday there was still no trade reported but asking prices were reported by Canfax at \$395.00-\$400.00 cwt delivered. Thursday saw light to moderate trade develop with sales from \$388.00-\$393.00 delivered on a dressed basis, steady with the previous week. Canfax reported that while a few cattle will be harvested quickly the majority have been scheduled for delivery towards the end of September.

The U.S. cash cattle trade for the week ending August 17th saw light trade on Wednesday with prices in the south at \$179.00 live, about \$1.00 lower than last week. There were no online auction sales reported from the Central Stockyards this week. There were 1,402 head on offer but all cattle were left unsold. Bids ranged from \$176.00-\$179.50 live which were below the reserve bids that ranged from \$180.00-\$184.00. On Thursday there were some scattered deals in the north, priced mostly at \$292.00 on the rail.
