Comments for the week ending August 31, 2023

There were 343 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week up 60 head from the previous week and 30 more than this time last year. Fed steers ranged from \$226.35-\$239.51 cwt averaging \$235.09 up \$2.32 cwt from the week before and \$54.45 higher than year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$218.90-\$240.21 cwt with a weekly weighted average price of \$231.51 up \$1.80 from last week and \$54.85 stronger than this time last year. Auction markets reported trade as steady to fully steady and higher in spots and ended the week actively at strong prices.

The Ontario railgrade market continued to trend sideways again this week but on limited volume. Steers were reported at \$389.00 dressed with heifers at \$388.00 cwt. Producers reported that delivery was being scheduled for the week of September 11th but sellers were not jumping at the prices. U.S. packer interest was also reported this week. This week's average price continues at \$83.00 cwt stronger than this time last year.

The Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier note last week's beef market overview: "Buyers in the U.S. have been fearful about supplies. Canadian buyers for their part are afraid that U.S. buyers are afraid. As usual Canadian demand is just so-so compared to the U.S., but Canadian buyers have to react to what U.S. buyer do. The weak dollar adds to the sting. The source of the U.S. fear relates to packer efforts to stem the slide in the cutout. The cutout fell for several weeks in a row during June and July. Packers reacted rationally by cutting kills in late July and August (or perhaps the cattle weren't there). In any event buyers, who still needed regular business product let alone Labor Day needs, reacted by paying higher and higher asking prices the last two weeks. Now, however, they are covered, and the meat is on the books. In the meantime, demand is still very good. The data indicates it is running as good or better than last year; but it is weakening week by week. In addition, now that buyers have the high-priced inventory on the books, the question is: will they increase prices again?" Kevin also notes: "Packers in Canada are in good shape. The U.S. draw has been very good, and packers have kept clean."

2,229 fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week up 356 head from the week before and 563 more than the same time last year. Cows this week ranged from \$106.15-\$158.77 averaging \$129.81 down \$0.10 from the previous week and \$30.14 cwt higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as steady to fully steady for the most part, with a couple of markets noting prices steady to stronger. In this week's offering there were 383 beef cows sold, up 73 head from the previous week averaging \$143.22 cwt down \$5.85 from last week's weighted average beef cow price.

Receipts of stocker and feeder cattle were up this week by 485 head at 3,289 with all auction markets regular sales resuming. This week's offering was 696 head above this time last year. Special fall stocker sales will be starting to surface in the coming weeks. Auction markets reported trade as strong with good quality calves trading fully steady while medium quality was just steady. Heavier cattle were reported as fully steady to stronger/higher on good demand. Actual average prices this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs down \$37.51 cwt on average, steers 500-600 lbs were up \$27.31, 600-700 lbs up \$31.83, 700-800 lbs up \$35.34, 800-900 lbs up \$21.69, 900-1000 lbs up \$13.26 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$14.23 cwt higher than last week on average. Heifers from 400-500 lbs were down \$32.64 cwt on average, 500-600 lbs down \$6.22, 600-700 lbs up \$24.17, 700-800 lbs up \$7.16, 800-900 lbs up \$2.91 cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$1.91 cwt higher than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week was reported at \$389.00 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, down \$2.25 cwt from the previous week's trade.

Alberta direct trade was light this week with trade reported from \$388.00-\$390.00 delivered on a dressed basis which is fully steady to last week. Canfax noted some live trade from \$230.00-\$231.25 cwt on a picked-up basis. Canfax reports that "Premiums have been noted if cattle grade over 70% AAA. Competition on the cash market remains limited but buying interest has been noted from all three western Canadian packers. Cattle that traded were being scheduled for anywhere from mid-September to early October delivery, depending on which packer bought the cattle. "

The U.S. cash cattle trade the week ending August 26th was light to moderate with business in the south fully steady to the previous week from \$178.00-\$179.00 live, majority at \$179.00 cwt. In the north trade ranged from \$183.00-\$191.00 live, mainly \$185.00 cwt down \$2.00-\$3.00. On the rail trade for the week ranged from \$290.00-\$295.00 dressed, mainly \$292.00-\$293.00 cwt down \$1.00-\$2.00. Overall average prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$182.75 cwt down \$2.29 while heifers averaged \$181.30 down \$3.49. On the rail steers averaged \$292.75 dressed down \$1.01 on average while heifers averaged \$292.54 down \$2.00 cwt from the previous week's weighted average prices.

The U.S. cash cattle trade this week was scattered at best until Thursday with just a few deals here and there reported but not enough to establish a market. A few deals in the south were noted at \$179.00 live, fully steady to last week. The north saw a couple of deals from \$184.00-\$186.00 live, steady to last week while dressed trade in Iowa was noted at \$290.00 which is \$2.00 -\$3.00 easier. Thursday, light to moderate trade developed with business in the south from \$178.00-\$179.00 live, most at \$179.00 which is steady to the previous week. In the north, trade ranged from \$288.00-\$294.00 dressed, mostly \$290.00-\$292.00 which is \$1.00-\$3.00 cwt lower. Some live trade in the north was noted from \$182.00-\$186.00 which is steady to \$2.00 cwt lower. Some light clean-up trade today is steady to the week's market.
