Comments for the week ending November 2, 2023.

Lighter receipts of 433 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week down 45 from the week before and 6 fewer than the same time last year. Fed steers saw a full trading range from \$214.93-\$236.87 averaging \$230.68 up \$0.17 cwt from the week before and \$48.95 higher than year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$226.05-\$239.84 averaging \$233.78 up \$3.75 cwt and \$55.69 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as steady with quality considered, to slightly easier.

The Ontario railgrade market continued at fully steady prices again this week with steers reported at \$395.00 cwt dressed and heifers at \$394.00. This is the seventh straight week at these prices. Cattle sold this week were being scheduled for delivery the week of December 4th. Trade was light as some producers are holding out for stronger prices. US packer interest was reported with some cattle selling south of the border this week. This week's average prices are \$90.50 cwt above last year at this time.

Larger receipts of fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week at 2,881 head down 27 from last week and 514 more than last year at this time. Cows sold from \$84.25-\$128.24 averaging \$103.92 down \$5.14 cwt from the previous week's trade but still \$25.08 above year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices slightly softer to start. By Tuesday trade was steady to easier with one market noting beef cows steady and dairy cows \$10.00 cwt lower. By mid week trade was reported as steady and ended the week selling actively at higher prices. This week saw 434 beef cows trade down 262 head from the previous week averaging \$112.45 cwt down \$4.73 from the previous week's weighted average beef cow price. Larger volumes of 2,447 dairy cows sold this week up 235 head from the previous week averaging \$101.10 down \$4.45 cwt from last week's average price.

The Ontario federally inspected processing volume as of October 28, 2023 totals 459,781 head, down 9.1 percent from the same time last year. In the mix, steers are down 10.9 percent, heifer volumes are 11 percent lower and cull cow processing volumes are 3.3 percent higher than last year at this time. Ontario steer carcass weights are trending steady to last year while heifers are slightly higher. Offsetting the lower processing volumes in Ontario has been increased demand in exports to the U.S. Live cattle exports to the US from Ontario are up 63 percent year over year with live steers up 747 percent as of August 31, 2023, live heifers are up 90 percent with cull cows up just 5 percent over the same time period in 2022.

Lighter receipts of 7,646 stocker and feeder cattle were sold through auction markets this week down 3,945 head from the week before but 211 more than the same time last year. The previous week saw several special stocker sales take place while just a couple took place this week. Auction markets reported good quality calves this week trading steady to fully steady, with one certified calf sale seeing steady to higher prices. Second cut and non-vaccinated calves sold easier to under pressure across the board. Yearling steers were noted as steady on strong demand while yearling heifers were steady on the choice cattle and easier on the second cut. By week's end trade was under pressure at easier prices. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs down \$32.91 cwt from the previous week's trade, 500-600 lbs down \$12.22, 600-700 lbs down \$23.39, 700-800 lbs down \$10.26, 800-900 lbs down \$36.62, 900-1000 lbs up \$9.31 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$0.33 higher than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$3.51 from last week on average, 400-500 lbs down \$52.99, 500-600 lbs down \$28.27, 600-700 lbs down \$12.59, 700-800 lbs down \$32.79, 800-900 lbs down \$3.92 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$4.40 cwt easier than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this ranged from \$387.00-\$388.25 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, up \$0.53 cwt from the previous week's trade.

Alberta direct trade was light with just a few cattle trading at \$390.00 cwt delivered which is fully steady to last week but too few sold to establish a market. Canfax reports: "Competition on the cash market remains limited and sale volumes are looking very light. Most of this week's cash offering will be carried into next week. For the end of October Canadian Prime and AAA grading percent was over 80%. This is one of the highest quality grade percentages on record."

The U.S. cash cattle trade the week ending October 27th was light in the south and light to moderate in the north. Business in the south ranged from \$180.00-\$185.00 live, majority from \$183.00-\$185.00 which is generally steady to the week before. In the north trade ranged from \$183.00-\$185.00 live with a few at \$186.00 Friday down \$2.50 on average while dressed deals ranged from \$287.00-\$292.00, majority around \$290.00 cwt down \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt. Overall average prices for the week reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$184.02 down \$2.12 cwt while heifers averaged \$184.22 down \$1.83 from the week before. On the rail steers averaged \$290.06 down \$3.51 cwt while heifers averaged \$289.99 down \$3.48 from the previous week's weighted average price.

This week the U.S. cattle trade has been fairly quiet with just a handful of trade late Tuesday in Texas at \$184.00 live on just 77 head, but not enough sold to establish a market. Wednesday saw a handful of cattle sell in the south at \$185.00 live which is steady to the top of last week's southern trade, but not enough sold to establish a market. The north has been very quiet with no trade reported. Thursday a few more cattle traded in the south at \$185.00 live but again, volumes were very limited. Bids in the north from \$290.00-\$292.00 dressed did not get any cattle bought as sellers held out for higher prices. Today a light trade is starting to surface in the north from \$184.00-\$185.00 live, mostly \$185.00 which is steady to last week, with some dressed trade at \$292.00-\$292.75 cwt, most at \$292.00 up \$2.00 from last week. The south is still very quiet with no bids on the table. Asking prices are sitting at \$188.00 live in the south and \$294.00 dressed in the north. Active trade is expected to develop at any time.
