



### Comments for the week ending December 21, 2023

With light receipts due to the upcoming holiday break, there were just 94 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets, down 232 from the week before and 70 fewer than the same time last year. Fed steers sold from \$201.35-\$239.96 averaging \$219.53 cwt up \$2.19 from the previous week and \$29.42 higher than year ago prices. Fed heifers ranged from \$214.73-\$233.43 averaging \$226.23 up \$4.94 from the previous week and \$37.80 above last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt lower to steady on light offerings.

The Ontario railgrade market was light this week. Trade the previous Friday and on Monday were noted at \$377.00 cwt dressed for steers and \$376.00 for heifers, down \$3.00 from the week before with delivery the week of January 8, 2024. By late Tuesday bids were reported at \$375.00 dressed for steers and \$374.00 for heifers with a very light test reported. Delivery is still being scheduled for the week of January 8, 2024. Overall prices for the week are averaging \$4.00 cwt lower than last week but \$56.00 cwt stronger than year ago prices.

Lighter receipts of fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week at 2,088 head, down 1,109 from last week and 54 fewer than the same time last year. Cows ranged from \$83.02-\$128.23 averaging \$103.76 down \$1.68 cwt overall from the week before but \$24.63 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady to slightly higher to start. As the week progressed trade was lower. 414 beef cows sold this week down 336 head from the previous week, averaging \$114.30 up \$0.52 cwt from last week's weighted average beef cow prices. 1,674 dairy cows sold this week down 773 head from the week before, averaging \$101.45 down \$1.72 from last week's weighted average dairy cow price.

3,039 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week down 2,254 head from the previous week but 413 more than the same time last year. Auction markets reported calves as \$5.00-\$10.00 cwt higher on the choice calves while second cut calves were steady with calves ending the week steady. Yearlings started out on a strong active trade at higher prices but by mid week trade was easier on the steers and steady on the heifers. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$7.22 on average, 500-600 lbs down \$3.92, 600-700 lbs up \$0.23, 700-800 lbs down \$2.49, 800-900 lbs down \$1.19, 900-1000 lbs down \$1.34 with steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$4.97 cwt lower than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$4.98 cwt, 400-500 lbs down \$13.47, 500-600 lbs up \$1.97, 600-700 lbs up \$5.14, 700-800 lbs down \$1.84, 800-900 lbs down \$21.39 with heifers 900 lbs and over averaging \$9.40 cwt easier than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$373.75 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, down \$3.13 cwt on average from the previous week's trade.

Alberta direct trade was reported by Canfax as light with sales at \$365.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis, down \$3.00-\$5.00 from last week. Canfax reports: "Competition on the cash market has been disappointing. US packer interest on the western Canadian cash market has also been quiet as well. Lift times continue to stretch out, in some instances cattle that were bid on this week would not be picked up until March. Alberta fed prices are trading at a discount to both the Ontario and US markets. Packers seem to be well covered with contract cattle and cash leverage has been limited."

The U.S. cash cattle trade the week ending December 16th saw live trade in the north and south range from \$165.00-\$170.00, mainly \$167.00-\$168.00 but by Friday southern live trade was mainly \$170.00. Dressed deals in the north ranged from \$264.00-270.00 with most trade from \$267.00-\$268.00 cwt. Overall average prices, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$168.71

down \$1.23 cwt while heifers averaged \$169.13 down \$1.24. On the rail steers averaged \$267.53 dressed down \$2.10 cwt while heifers averaged \$267.30 down \$3.88.

The U.S. cash cattle trade this week has been light all week with trade in the north from \$170.00-\$172.00 live and \$268.00-\$272.00 dressed, mainly \$270.00 up \$2.00 cwt on average. The south has been limited with sellers passing most bids of \$170.00 live. Today a light trade in the north has developed at \$271.00 dressed, up \$3.00 from last week while a light trade in the south is surfacing at \$171.00 live up \$1.00 cwt from last week's southern trade. Business is expected to continue into the late afternoon with asking prices sitting at \$173.00-\$175.00 live in the south and \$272.00 plus dressed in the north. At 3:00 pm this afternoon the Cattle On Feed Report was released. Cattle on feed volumes on December 1st are up 3 percent over last year while placements are down 2 percent. Marketings for November were also down 7 percent over last year.
