

Comments for the week ending February 1, 2024

There were 489 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week up 102 from the week before and 133 more than the same time last year. Fed steers sold from \$223.38-\$237.72 live averaging \$231.03 cwt up \$6.53 cwt from last week's trade and \$38.58 stronger than year ago prices. Fed heifers saw a wide trading range from \$207.63-\$231.88 averaging \$224.39 down \$2.49 from the previous week and \$42.22 higher than this time last year. Auction markets reported trade as steady to fully steady but by week's end the market was \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt higher.

The Ontario railgrade market was light early week with prices steady to the top of the previous week's trade at \$385.00 cwt dressed for steers and \$384.00 for heifers. Delivery of the cattle sold was reported for the week of February 5th. By Thursday trade was up \$5.00 cwt with steers reported at \$390.00 dressed and heifers \$389.00 with immediate to February 5th delivery being scheduled. Prices for the week averaged \$4.75 cwt stronger than last week on average. U.S. packer interest continues on the Ontario cash market.

The boxed beef report by Kevin Grier this week described the spot market, Canadian product availability as: "Canadian packers have found steady sales to the south over the past few weeks but that is changing. In addition, processing volumes in Canada were very large last week with both packers working on Saturday. Both packers have work to do on nearby inventories."

2,583 fed/cull cows sold this week through auction markets, up 123 head from the previous week and fully steady to the same time last year. Cows sold from \$98.23-\$136.84 cwt averaging \$115.86 down \$7.24 cwt from the previous week but \$16.28 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady to start but as the week progressed trade was reported as continuing strong with prices slightly lower to easier and \$4.00 cwt easier. The market ended the week trading barely steady. 483 beef cows sold this week up 162 head from the previous week averaging \$123.92 down \$8.8.53 cwt, with 2,100 dairy cows trading down 39 from the previous week, averaging \$114.72 down \$8.63 cwt on average.

Larger receipts of 4,864 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, up 1,838 head from last week and 1,015 more than this time last year. Auction markets started this reporting period at higher prices, with steer calves up \$5.00-\$10.00 cwt and heifer calves up \$10.00-\$20.00 cwt. Yearling heifers were noted as \$8.00-\$10.00 stronger with yearling steers up \$3.00-\$5.00 cwt from the week before. Two special vaccinated sales this week noted prices higher on good demand. By midweek trade was active on the heavier cattle at higher prices. By Thursday, trade was very active with steer calves higher to sharply stronger and heifer calves fully steady to higher. Yearlings sold on an active trade at higher prices. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were up \$17.91 cwt from the week before, steers 500-600 lbs were up \$20.19, 600-700 lbs up \$21.29, 700-800 lbs up \$5.66, 800-900 lbs up \$3.82 cwt, 900-1000 lbs up \$7.41 while steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$2.52 lower than the week before. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were up \$64.14 cwt on average, 400-500 lb heifers up \$5.13, 500-600 lbs up \$8.26, 600-700 lbs up \$7.40 cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$15.37, 800-900 lbs heifers up \$18.27 with heifers 900 lbs and over up \$8.66 cwt from last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$383.73-\$387.25 cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, up \$6.93 cwt from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light with prices reported as steady from \$360.00-\$365.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis reported Canfax. Canfax also notes: "Cattle that traded were being scheduled anywhere from the second half of February to the second half of March delivery depending on the packer. This week buying interest was noted from two Pacific Northwest slaughter plants. Light volumes of Western Canadian fed cattle were marketed South, these cattle will be priced off the five-area average."

The U.S. cash cattle trade the week ending January 26th was moderate in volume on Thursday with southern trade from \$174.00-\$176.00 cwt, mainly \$175.00 up \$1.00-\$2.00 cwt. In the north live trade was from \$174.00-\$179.00, mainly \$176.00 with dressed deals from \$274.00-\$279.50 dressed, most at \$277.00 up \$2.00-\$3.00 from the previous week. Overall average prices for the week, released by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers averaged \$175.44 up \$1.68 cwt while live heifers averaged \$175.05 up \$0.87. On the rail steers averaged \$276.87 dressed up \$2.98 cwt while heifers averaged \$276.80 up \$3.10 from the week before.

The U.S. cash cattle trade this week was basically untested the first half of the week with just a couple of deals in Kansas and Iowa from \$175.00-\$176.00 live and \$275.00 dressed, but not nearly enough to establish a market trend. This week's show-list is reported as slightly higher in the northern states and lower in Kansas, while Texas is slightly lower. Wednesday saw a light test in Kansas at \$176.00 live, up \$1.00 cwt but again, not enough to establish a market. On Wednesday afternoon the January 1st US Cattle Inventory was released, after the board closed, with all cattle and calves in the United States down 2 percent from January 1, 2023 and within analyst's predictions which was expected to be neutral to the market. However, Thursday light to moderate trade developed at higher prices in all feeding states. Business in the south ranged from mainly \$178.00-\$179.00 live up \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt from last week's southern deals. In the north trade ranged from \$277.00-\$283.00 dressed, mainly \$280.00 up \$3.00 from last week with some live trade noted from \$176.00-\$178.00 which is steady to \$3.00 stronger than last week's northern prices. Today, bids of \$179.00 live have surfaced in Kansas and \$280.00 dressed in the north, but no trade has developed at this time.
