





Comments for the week ending May 22, 2025

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 230 head, were down 134 head from the previous week and 101 head lower than the same time last year. Fed steers averaged \$295.56/cwt, up \$1.49/cwt from last week and \$49.82/cwt above last year. Fed heifers averaged \$296.09/cwt, up \$2.63/cwt from last week and \$51.08/cwt higher than last year. Auction markets reported after the long weekend holiday, fed steers and heifers sold strong at \$3.00-5.00/cwt higher.

In Ontario this week, dressed sales were reported \$500/cwt delivered, steady to \$5/cwt higher than the previous week. For the week ending May 17th, Eastern Canadian processing was 4.9% below a year ago and 12.0% below the five-year average. YTD processing is down 4%, with steers down 4% and heifers down 2%, cows down 5% and bulls down 39%. For the week ending May 10th, Eastern fed cattle and cow exports to the US were 3,090 head, 19% below last year but 19% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern fed cattle and cow exports and cow exports are up 35% from last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets this week were 1,307 head, down 327 head from last week and down 456 head from last year. Cows averaged \$177.73/cwt, up \$0.30/cwt from last week and up \$37.57/cwt from last year. Beef cows averaged \$187.41/cwt, down \$1.50/cwt from the previous week's trade but \$32.18/cwt above year ago prices. Auction markets reported that after the holiday, cows sold strong at steady prices. On May 22nd, cows sold on good demand at steady to stronger prices.

Smaller receipts of 3,725 stocker and feeder cattle sold through Ontario auction markets this week, down 1,126 head from the previous week but 122 head more than the same week last year. In the feeder market, steer prices were up \$5/cwt on average compared to last week with heifers up \$2/cwt. Auction markets

reported last week stockers sold on a sharply stronger market. This week on May 21st, feeder cattle sold on a steady trade and all classes of stockers sold fully steady. On May 22nd, stockers continued to sell actively at stronger prices. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$24.86/cwt weaker than last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$3.75/cwt, 600-700 lbs down \$6.39/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$27.13/cwt, 800-900 lbs were up \$16.16/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs up \$14.35/cwt and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$6.34/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$47.22/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs up \$21.96/cwt, 500-600 lbs up \$0.13/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$11.69/cwt, 700-800 lbs down \$3.49/cwt, 800-900 lbs up \$11.34/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$19.81/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. For the week ending May 10th, Eastern feeder exports to the US were 390 head, 43% lower than last year and 27% below the five-year average. YTD Eastern feeder exports are down 17% from last year.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$495.00/cwt dressed on a picked-up basis.

Alberta fed trade last week saw dressed sales reported from \$495-500/cwt delivered. The Alberta fed cash-to-futures basis was reported at +\$0.33/cwt, the strongest basis seen this year. Canadian Prime and AAA grading was reported over 81%, record high for the first half of May. Fed prices have trended steady to higher for the past ten weeks, gaining \$33/cwt or around \$500/head. The fed market is likely getting close to a peak. Many producers have indicated a larger percentage of their May cattle are contracted, given the uncertainty surrounding US tariffs. For the week ending May 17th, Western Canadian fed processing was 36,368 head, 4.1% lower than last year. This week on May 21st, light trade developed with dressed sales reported at \$500/cwt delivered, steady to \$5/cwt higher than the previous week. Asking prices on the few cattle left on the showlist are at \$502-505/cwt delivered.

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$350-360/cwt (mostly \$358/cwt), \$2/cwt stronger than the previous week. Live sales in the North were at \$229/cwt, \$1-4/cwt higher. Sales in Texas and Kansas ranged from \$218-220/cwt, fully steady. This week on Tuesday May 20th, light trade was reported in Kansas with live sales marked at \$219/cwt, fully steady with the previous week. Sales in Kansas were from \$224-227/cwt, \$6-7/cwt higher. On Wednesday May 21st, light trade was reported in lowa and Nebraska with dressed sales ranging from \$360-370/cwt, \$5-10/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in the North were from \$230-231/cwt, \$2-3/cwt stronger.

In the U.S., the All-fresh beef retail price for the month of April was reported at \$8.50/lb, up \$0.08/lb from the previous month, setting new highs. Choice at \$349.90/cwt, was \$2/cwt stronger than the previous week with Select at \$339.18/cwt, up \$6/cwt. Load counts totaled 560 loads, up 36.75 loads from the previous week. A stronger tone was noted on Choice end meats with Chuck and Round up \$1.65-5.00/cwt. Middle meats ranged from \$0.85/cwt stronger to \$12.25/cwt softer than the previous week. Select end meats rallied \$4.75/cwt higher than the previous week while middle meats outperformed their Choice counterparts, climbing \$6.45-11.35/cwt higher. Lean 90% trim was \$380.30/cwt, up \$5.60/cwt from two weeks ago when prices were last published. US retail beef prices are expected to continue moving higher this summer as a historically small US beef cattle herd comes up against strong demand from consumers who want to purchase hamburgers, steaks, and ribs for outdoor grilling.
