



#### Comments for the week ending July 10, 2025

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 487 head, were up 3 head from the previous week but 106 head smaller than the same time last year. Fed steers averaged \$314.50/cwt, up \$4.01/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$75.14/cwt above year ago prices. Fed heifers averaged \$315.21/cwt, up \$5.03/cwt from last week and \$76.77/cwt higher than last year. This week, auction markets reported fed steers and heifers sold actively at prices \$3.00-\$5.00/cwt higher.

In Ontario, dressed sales have been reported at \$520/cwt delivered, steady with the previous week. For the week ending July 5<sup>th</sup>, Eastern Canadian processing was 184.6% above a year ago but 0.9% below the five-year average. Year-over-year comparisons were impacted by the 2024 labour strike in Guelph. YTD processing is up 14% from a year ago, with steers up 14% and heifers up 22%, cows up 6% and bulls down 37%. For the week ending June 28<sup>th</sup>, Eastern fed cattle and cow exports to the U.S. were 3,463 head, 32% below last year but 46% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern fed cattle and cow exports are up 13% from last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets this week were 1,471 head, up 251 head from last week but down 317 head from last year. Cows averaged \$191.91/cwt, up \$3.61/cwt from last week and up \$38.29/cwt from last year. Beef cow prices averaged \$208.54/cwt, down \$10.78/cwt from the previous week's trade but \$45.14/cwt above year ago prices. Auction markets reported last week cows sold actively at steady prices. This week, all classes of cows and bulls sold fully steady to stronger. A good offering of cows and bulls sold \$2.00-\$5.00 higher.

Receipts of 3,108 stocker and feeder cattle sold through Ontario auction markets this week, up 806 head from the previous week and 1,473 head more than the same week last year. In the feeder market, steer prices were up \$15.16/cwt on average compared to last week with heifers up \$10.95/cwt. Auction markets reported this week at Keady Livestock Market lighter feeder cattle sold \$5.00-\$10.00/cwt higher, heavier feeders sold on a good demand with slightly higher prices. Stockers sold steady to stronger with good heifers bringing premiums. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$2.95/cwt higher than last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$40.15/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$24.83/cwt, 700-800 lbs up

\$1.61/cwt, 800-900 lbs were up \$12.72/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs up \$18.12/cwt and steers 1000 lbs plus averaged \$5.76/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$55.32/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs up \$4.70/cwt, 500-600 lbs up \$37.28/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$32.44/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$18.36/cwt, 800-900 lbs up \$33.32/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$5.84/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. For the week ending June 28<sup>th</sup>, Eastern feeder exports to the U.S. were 846 head, 13% lower than last year and 65% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern feeder exports are down 15% from last year.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$522.25-526.00/cwt dressed on a picked-up basis, which is up \$3.38/cwt from the previous week's trade.

Alberta fed trade last week saw dressed sales reported at \$496-500/cwt delivered, \$2/cwt lower than the previous week. The Alberta cash-to-futures basis adjusted sharply with the move to the August contract, to +\$10.24/cwt, this is \$7.12/cwt stronger than the five-year average and the strongest for the same week since 2018. In June, fed prices averaged \$299.44/cwt, up \$1.78/cwt from May. For the week ending July 5<sup>th</sup>, Western Canadian fed processing was 37,909 head, 3.3% lower than last year. On July 9<sup>th</sup>, light trade developed with dressed sales ranging from \$495-500/cwt delivered, steady to \$1/cwt lower than last week.

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Nebraska ranged from \$368-370/cwt with live sales from \$232-233/cwt. Sales in Texas and Kansas were mostly at \$222-224/cwt, though there was some Thursday trade up to \$225/cwt. On the Fed Cattle Exchange, one lot of cash cattle traded in Kansas at \$225/cwt and one lot traded in Iowa via Bid the Grid at \$228/cwt. Choice cutouts ended the week around \$5/cwt softer than last week, with Select down just over \$1/cwt; 90% trim moved \$7/cwt higher and 73% ground eased \$26/cwt.

In the U.S., across the 48 continental states, 43% of pasture is rated good to excellent, steady with last week but down from 48% a year ago. Pasture conditions rated good or excellent in the top five beef cow states vary significantly: Texas (50%), Oklahoma (71%), Missouri (88%), Nebraska (32%), and South Dakota (42%). On July 7<sup>th</sup>, the U.S. government announced a 25% blanket tariff on goods imported from fourteen different countries that would come into effect on August 1<sup>st</sup>. Japan and South Korea have both said they would try to negotiate with the U.S. to soften the impact. The port at Douglas, Arizona closed to feeder imports from Mexico only a couple of days after opening. New World Screwworm was discovered 370 miles south of the US-Mexico border.
