





#### Comments for the week ending September 18, 2025

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 495 head, were down 15 head from the previous week and 258 head larger than the same time last year. Fed steers averaged \$327.09/cwt, down \$1.26/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$86.06/cwt above year ago prices. Fed heifers averaged \$325.17/cwt, up \$0.38/cwt from last week and \$95.15/cwt higher than last year. Auction markets report that fed steers and heifers sold steady to \$2.00-\$3.00 lower.

In Ontario, dressed sales have been reported at \$542/cwt delivered, fully steady with last week. Cattle are being booked for early October delivery. For the week ending September 13th Eastern Canadian processing was 13.5% below a year ago and 16.8% below the five-year average. YTD processing is up 6% from a year ago, with steers up 5% and heifers up 8%, cows up 9% and bulls down 23%. For the week ending September 6th, Eastern fed cattle and cow exports to the U.S. were 2,409 head, 18% below last year and 14% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern fed cattle and cow exports were 2% lower than last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets this week were 1,653 head, up 38 head from last week and up 220 head from last year. Cows averaged \$196.09/cwt, down \$5.52/cwt from last week and up \$44.32/cwt from last year. Beef cow prices averaged \$217.26/cwt, down \$8.85/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$56.01/cwt above year ago prices. Auction markets report that cull cows continued to sell very strong at steady prices at Denfield Livestock Exchange.

Total receipts were 8,737 head this week. Receipts of 4,725 stocker and feeder cattle sold through Ontario auction markets this week, up 37 head from the previous week but 489 head less than the same week last year. Auction markets report stockers sold at steady prices while feeder cattle sold actively at stronger prices. In the feeder market, steer prices were up \$15.50/cwt on average compared to last week with heifers down \$0.27/cwt. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$21.65/cwt stronger than last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$6.80/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$26.19/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$22.06/cwt, 800-900 lbs were up \$30.68/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs down \$4.45/cwt and steers 1,000 lbs plus averaged \$5.55/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were up \$18.96/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs down \$16.31/cwt, 500-600 lbs down \$12.79/cwt, 600-700 lbs up \$2.76/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$21.22/cwt, 800-900 lbs down \$19.68/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$3.97/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. For the week ending September 6th, Eastern feeder exports to the U.S. were 1,141 head, 29% higher than last year and 55% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern feeder exports are down 10% from last year.

The Quebec electronic market prices are not available at press time.

Alberta direct trade last week saw dressed sales reported at \$525.00-527.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$2.00/cwt stronger than the previous week. Alberta fed prices continued to put in new record highs, with fed steers and heifers averaging \$317.26/cwt and \$311.69/cwt respectively. Fed cattle are now trading \$11.44-16.12/cwt higher than the summer highs. The Alberta cash-to-futures basis is reported at -3.34, the strongest basis in eight weeks and 1.95 stronger than the five year average. For the week ending September 13th, Western Canadian fed processing was 40,982 head, 3.9% lower than last year. This week on Wednesday September 17th, light trade developed with dressed sales and bids reported from \$520-525/cwt delivered, steady to \$2/cwt lower than last week.

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw light trade reported in the North in a wide-ranging \$373-382/cwt dressed (mostly \$375/cwt), around \$8/cwt softer than the previous week's average. Live sales ranged from \$237-240/cwt, \$2-5/cwt softer. Trade in the South ranged from \$238-240/cwt (mostly \$240/cwt), \$2/cwt softer than the previous week. This week on September 17th, light trade was reported in Texas with live sales marked at \$239/cwt, \$1/cwt lower than last week. Live sales in lowa were at \$235/cwt, \$3-5/cwt softer. On September 18th, live bids of \$236.00/cwt (North) and \$239/cwt (South) were noted, and a few cattle traded in Nebraska. By the end of last week, both Choice and Select eased seasonally lower, with Choice softening just shy of \$13.50/cwt and Select slipping almost \$8/cwt. Trims and grinds strengthened \$4-14/cwt from the previous week and were a wide ranging \$47-100/cwt stronger than last year.

USDA published its September WASDE report on September 12th. Total corn production is estimated at 16.8 billion bushels, up 72 million bushels from last month's report. Beef production for 2025 is projected at 25.9 billion pounds and was revised down by 100 million pounds from the August report. Total supply is estimated at 31.9 billion pounds (-10 million pounds) on larger imports (+90 million pounds) and smaller exports (-40 million pounds). Per capita consumption for 2025 is projected at 58.5 lbs/person, steady with August but down 0.6 lbs/person from last year. Beef production for 2026 is forecasted to be down 1.3% compared to 2025. According to USDA, the All-fresh beef retail price for the month of August was reported \$9.18/lb, a new record high.
