



Comments for the week ending November 7, 2025

Fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 393 head, were up 57 head from the previous week and 128 head larger than the same time last year. Fed steers averaged \$308.06/cwt, up \$7.61/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$62.28/cwt above year ago prices. Fed heifers averaged \$302.29/cwt, down \$3.90/cwt from last week and \$59.21/cwt higher than last year. Auction markets reported fed steers and heifers sold \$2.00-\$3.00/cwt higher at Brussels Livestock but \$3.00/cwt lower at Ontario Livestock Exchange.

In Ontario, light trade has been reported at \$520/cwt delivered, steady with the previous week. Cattle were being booked for the week of November 24th delivery. For the week ending November 1st Eastern Canadian processing was 2.0% below a year ago and 6.4% below the five-year average. YTD processing is up 4% from a year ago, with steers up 1% and heifers up 7%, cows up 9% and bulls down 15%. For the week ending October 25th, Eastern fed cattle and cow exports to the U.S. were 3,698 head, 21% above last year and 35% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern fed cattle and cow exports were 1% lower than last year.

Cull cow receipts sold through auction markets this week were 2,529 head, up 430 head from last week and up 101 head from last year. Cows averaged \$171.31/cwt, down \$1.92/cwt from last week and up \$31.63/cwt from last year. Beef cow prices averaged \$183.08/cwt, up \$5.71/cwt from the previous week's trade and \$31.06/cwt above year ago prices. Auction markets reported at Keady Livestock Market, cull cows and bulls sold under pressure with quality considered. Cull cows traded lower at Denfield Livestock Exchange.

Total receipts were 13,552 head this week. Receipts of 8,848 stocker and feeder cattle sold through Ontario auction markets this week, up 444 head from the previous week and 1,774 more than the same week last year. Auction markets reported all classes of stockers sold steady. In the feeder market, steer prices were down \$7.32/cwt on average compared to last week with heifers down \$9.90/cwt. Actual average prices collected this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs trading \$10.75/cwt weaker than last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$11.93/cwt, 600-700 lbs down \$25.81/cwt, 700-800 lbs down \$12.23/cwt, 800-900 lbs were up \$6.38/cwt, steers 900-1000 lbs down \$1.23/cwt and steers 1,000 lbs plus averaged \$4.32/cwt stronger than the previous week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$28.16/cwt from last week on average, 400-500 lbs down \$21.43/cwt, 500-600 lbs down \$20.32/cwt, 600-700 lbs down \$7.17/cwt, 700-800 lbs up \$7.10/cwt, 800-900 lbs up \$14.02/cwt and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$13.34/cwt weaker than the previous week's weighted average prices. For the week ending October 25th, Eastern feeder exports to the U.S. were 1,152 head, 35% lower than last year and 29% above the five-year average. YTD Eastern feeder exports are down 16% from last year.

The Quebec electronic market prices are not available at press time.

Alberta direct trade last week saw light trade reported with dressed sales ranging from \$495-505/cwt delivered. The Alberta cash-to-futures fed basis was -20.31, steady with the three-year average. After declining \$17/cwt over the past eight weeks, the fed market is starting to show signs of stability holding around \$300/cwt. For the week ending November 1st, Western Canadian fed processing was 32,507 head, 19% lower than last year. On October 5th, light trade developed with dressed sales ranging from \$493-495/cwt delivered, \$2-10/cwt lower than the previous week. Asking prices have moderated to around \$500-505/cwt delivered.

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$355-360/cwt, \$5-12/cwt lower than the previous week. Live sales in the North were from \$229-230/cwt, \$7/cwt softer. Light trade occurred in the Southern feeding states with sales ranging from \$235-236/cwt, \$2-3/cwt lower. Choice and Select cutouts ended the week up either side of \$5/cwt. Fatty 50% trim ended the week up \$26/cwt from the previous week with 73% ground up \$20/cwt. Lean 90% trim was \$6/cwt softer. On October 5th, live sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$230-230.50/cwt while dressed sales ranged from \$355-365/cwt (mostly \$360/cwt), fully steady with the previous week. Live sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$232/cwt, \$2-3/cwt softer.

Despite speculation, the US border remains closed to Mexican feeder cattle. From their August highs, butcher cow prices have declined \$5/cwt. It was announced that China has agreed to purchase 12 million metric tons of soybeans from the US this year and 25 million metric tons over each of the next three years. Soybeans rallied on this news, with the January 2026 contract trading at the highest point since July 2024. Strength in the soybean market supported the corn complex as well.
