

Let Your Local Beef Breeder Co-operative Work for You!

What the Co-operative Does for You

Additional Costs to Members May Include

A Simple Four Step Process:

1. Beef producer applies to the co-operative's board of directors* for membership.
2. After becoming a member, producer applies for a purchase order for the amount of anticipated breeding livestock purchase, loan of \$75,000+ depending on the co-operative.
3. Once the member receives purchase order, breeding livestock may be purchased.
4. The co-operative facilitates the payment for the breeding cattle.

* Each co-operative has a board of directors, which is made up of local beef producers who are also members.

- ▶ Attractive interest rate.
- ▶ Annual payments with loan financed over five years.
- ▶ Financing up to 100%.
- ▶ Loans may be obtained for replacement heifers, youthful cows or cow-calf pairs.
- ▶ Limited financial information required for application.
- ▶ Lending is based on producer's integrity and ability to feed and manage a cow herd.
- ▶ Co-operative supplies ID ear tags (not RFID), handles all paperwork for loan, administers all correspondence with the lender, and insures the cattle.

- ▶ Annual membership fee.
- ▶ 15% security deposit required. This deposit can be drawn upon by the co-op in the event there is a major shortfall in the co-op.
- ▶ Costs that may be included in the loan:
 - ▶ Processing fee
 - ▶ Co-op ear tags
 - ▶ Cattle insurance
 - ▶ PMSI registration
